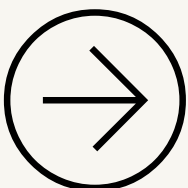

# ACTION UPDATE

**Peace Education Adoption Update:** Since our first newsletter, more European countries have shown interest in incorporating peace studies principles into schools. However, systematic implementation remains a challenge. We reaffirm the need for explicit skill-building into existing curricula.

**New Curriculum Materials:** HOPE recently released educational materials on conflict resolution, human rights, and multicultural awareness tailored to different age groups. These resources are now available for educators on our website.

**Teacher Training Workshops:** HOPE organizes teacher training workshops focused on interactive and experiential peace pedagogy to enhance capacity. The first sessions will be held this summer in partnership with education departments.

**Youth Exchange Program Launch:** HOPE is launching an exchange program this year. Participants will collaborate on peacebuilding workshops and community service initiatives. This represents an exciting step forward.
